

MapInfo Professional Patch Releases for v10.5.3 and 11.0.3 Now Available

Pitney Bowes Software is pleased to announce the latest update to MapInfo Professional. This release is available for free to MapInfo Professional v11.0 users. You can obtain this update by opening MapInfo Professional 11.0, and selecting the "Check for Update..." option under the Help menu.

MapInfo Professional 11.0.3 is a cumulative update that includes everything that was updated with 11.0.1 plus additional fixes. You can apply this update to MapInfo Professional 11.0, 11.0.1, or 11.0.2.

Version 10.5.3 patch

For those customers who are under Annual Maintenance but have not yet upgraded their copy to version 11, you may have noticed that from January 1st you have not been able to access the Microsoft Bing™ Imagery. You will need to apply the 10.5.3 patch to continue to use the Microsoft Bing™ imagery until the end of 2012. Nominated representatives for each client will have received an email with details on how to obtain this patch. If you have any difficulties just contact the CDR team.

New in v11.0.3 patch

Browser window sorting has been improved for this update. The Sort dialog box no longer opens a new Browser window. Instead, it sorts the existing Browser window.

The MapInfo Professional 11.0.3 update adds support for Google Earth Enterprise Tile Servers. If you have access to a Google Earth server, then you would create TAB and XML files for each Google layer that you wish to use. There is no support for a public Google server; this feature lets you get data from a private Google Earth Enterprise Server.
