Find my nearest

Multiple layers can be set up for 'find nearest' searches and be categorised, for example by transport, health and environment. Search results are shown on a map as clickable markers, and custom markers can be added.

Zero vulnerabilities

Stratus Connect 2.0 is fully secured against malicious attacks with zero vulnerability, having undergone industrial strength penetration testing for the web. It also features added support for Microsoft Internet Explorer 8, with up-to-date browser compatibility.

Automated tasks for the administrator

GIS administrators can schedule updates to the gazetteer index on a daily, weekly or custom basis. Critically, several usability improvements reduce the time spent administering the system and ensure data is live and up-to-date.
